Home Learning

- Class teachers are putting weekly plans on the website for you to use. You do not have to do everything on them! You are welcome to use work from different year groups if it is more suitable for your child.
- There are excellent <u>daily lessons available through the BBC website</u>. The BBC are also producing daily educational television programmes.
- The Oak National Academy are producing daily lessons for each year group.
- Adapt work so that it is more accessible to your child. For example, if your child does not want to record their learning in writing, you could scribe for them or take a photo or they could type it up, record it verbally or draw a picture.
