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<u>Maths:</u> Please complete the tasks below. If you don't have a printer please draw out the tasks or a similar version to complete.

- Monday: Easter number ordering to 20
- Tuesday: Easter counting
- Wednesday: Easter Egg addition
- Thursday: Easter number bonds to 10
- Friday: Easter repeating patterns

English: Easter

- Monday: I can listen to the Easter story and talk about the key events. Watch the story of Easter Sunday here: <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/stories/lets-celebrate-easterperformance</u>. Can you tell the key events in the correct order? Use the worksheet on the website to help you match the sentences to the correct picture to retell the story. You could cut and stick the sentences or write them next to the picture.
- Tuesday: I can use the sounds I know to spell. Sound out the words to match the pictures on the worksheet then have a go at writing the words in the space below the pictures. All of the pictures are things we might see at Easter.
- Wednesday: I can write a list using the sounds I know to spell. Find out about a different symbol of Easter. Can you write a list of symbols on the worksheet provided? Remember to think carefully about the sounds, particularly the initial sound of your word. You can draw a little picture for each symbol on your list too!
- Thursday: I can order instructions. I have given you some a set of instructions for how to make some yummy egg nest cakes. Please read the information about instructions with your grown up and have a go at putting the instructions in the correct order.
- Friday: I can create my own instructions. Use the worksheet provided to add the missing word (bossy word) into the instructions. Make sure you draw a little picture to go with each step!

This week we will be thinking about Easter.

Remember you can now upload work directly to your child's learning journal using the School360 parent app! <u>Phonics:</u> Have a go at the below activities (found on the website) in whichever order you wish. These activities will help to revise the sounds taught so far and practise our blending and segmenting skills.

- Easter CVC words
- Easter phase 3 words

- Easter colour by sound
- Easter spelling test
- Phase 2 tricky word spellings
- Continue to use phonics play at your leisure.

Other Areas of Learning: To complete throughout the week **Expressive Arts and Design:**

- Use the image below to have a go at painting/drawing your own daffodils. Look closely at the shapes of the petals and the colours and see if you can recreate it.
- Can you make an Easter card for your family? There are some examples on the next page.

Communication and Language:

- Can you talk about how the people felt during these moments of the Easter story?
