Mathematics: This week we are learning about number 5 (see page 2 and additional PDF files for practical maths activities)

- Can you complete any of the practical number 5 activities on page 2? Can your grown up upload it onto school 360?
- Can you complete the Numberblocks: High Five Activity (this is in your home learning pack and the PDF file is also attached)
- Can you complete any of the Maths: All about the Number 5 Home Learning Challenges (this is in your home learning pack and the PDF file is also attached)
- Can you create number 5? You could paint, draw, collage or even make number 5 out of playdough.
- Can you find and count 5 different items from around your house?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- This week in literacy we are reading the story LuLu gets a cat. LuLu loves cats. Can you talk to your grown up and tell them what/who you love?

Physical Development:

- Can you practise your cutting skills and do one of the activities from your home learning pack?
- Can you practise your colouring in skills and colour in your minibeast dictionary colouring sheet (in your home learning pack)
- Can you take part in a Cosmic Kids Yoga session on youtube?

Understanding the World:

Can you watch the numberblocks episode of number 5 and talk to your grown up about what you can see?



The number 5 can be shown in lots of different ways.






