# **Guidance for parents on home learning.**

Home learning packs, which have additional resources in to use, are available at the school office; these are to support you throughout the half term.

## Maths:

We are using the White Rose Maths scheme that we follow in school. On the home learning page of our school website you will find a weekly plan of the learning objectives to be covered throughout the week. Each day there will be a video delivering the lesson and explaining the mathematical concept. Alongside the video, there will be a worksheet attached to the home learning to complete.

You will need to print the worksheets from the home learning section of the website. If you do not have access to a printer, do not worry, your child can simply complete the work on a piece of paper or their workbook that I included in the pack sent home.

#### **English:**

We are using the CLPE scheme that we follow in school. Each week will focus on a book or a page from the given book. You will need to look at the CLPE worksheets that are included in your pack, and that are also available to be downloaded from the home learning link on our school website. These are labelled in according weeks.

The first plan to work from is, **Week 1- Oliver and the Seawigs by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre** Each week there are 5 sections; we have broken these down to be completed on different days.

Monday – Explore it

Tuesday – Illustrate it

Wednesday - Talk about it

Thursday - Imagine it

Friday - Create it

Throughout the weekly plan you will be asked to complete different questions and activities based on the extract. Record your responses in full sentences in your workbook or on a piece of paper.

### **Foundation Subjects:**

Throughout the week there will also be different foundation subject lessons to complete.

These will differ from week to week but throughout the term there will be a variety of:

Science, Art, D&T, History, Geography, RE, PE and Computing.

Planning for this will be attached to the home learning document.

If your child needs their passwords please email me on the address below and I will send you the details.
