Other Areas of Learning: To complete throughout the week

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Can you make a minibeast from a paper plate?
- Can you make a junk model minibeast?

Communication and Language:

- Listen to (or read if you have the book) the story 'What the Ladybird Heard'. Can you hear the rhyming words? See if you can spot them with your grown up.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Can you play a turn taking game with someone in your house? Make sure you wait your turn!
- Can you talk to your grown up about someone or something you are grateful for? What do they/does it do for you? What would you do without them/it? How do they/does it make you feel?

Physical Development:

- Can you move like minibeasts? Think of a minibeast and see if you can move how they would (e.g. slither like a worm). There is a minibeast action sheet in your home learning pack to help you.
- Can you use the cutting activities in your home learning pack to practise your cutting skills? Remember scissors are sharp and you should hold them correctly (even when you're not using them)!
- Have another dough disco to get those fingers moving!
