Dear Parent/Carer,

Currently, we have a growing number of children testing positive across the school.

If your child develops any symptoms or feels unwell, we would like to encourage you to carry out a lateral flow test immediately. The symptoms for each child can be varied, therefore, we would like to act with caution.

If your child tests positive and is asymptomatic, they must self-isolate for a minimum of 5 days (if they have negative lateral flow test results on days 5 and 6 they are allowed to end their self-isolation on day 6). They must continue to self-isolate until they have had two negative consecutive lateral flow tests within 10 days from the date of the first lateral flow test.

If your child tests positive and is symptomatic, they must book a PCR test immediately. They must self-isolate for a minimum of 5 days from when they started to become symptomatic. They can finish their isolation period if they have two negative lateral flow test results on days 5 and 6 and no longer have a raised temperature. If they continue to test positive, they must continue to self-isolate until they have had two negative consecutive lateral flow tests within 10 days from the date of when they became symptomatic. They are to continue to self-isolate if they have a raised temperature after the 10 days.
