


Covid-19 Guidance 11.01.22

Dear Parents/Carers,

The government announced last week, that from today, 11th January, those who do not have symptoms and have a positive lateral flow will still have to self-isolate but will no longer take a PCR test.

The guidance around self-isolation and testing is changing on a regular basis. Therefore, please refer to the diagram below which indicates the actions required depending on each individual's situation.



## **Daily testing for close contacts**

People who are fully vaccinated, or children and young people aged between 5 and 18 years and 6 months, identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19, should take an LFD test every day for seven days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result or develop symptoms at any time. This is so that any subsequent positive cases can be quickly picked up and for self-isolation to begin as soon as possible.
