Dear Parents of Nursery, Reception, Year 1, 2, 5 & 6 Children,

As you may have heard, we have been advised that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the school.

We have carried out a full risk assessment and identified all those who have been in close contact with the affected case and have recommended that they stay at home and self-isolate until 10 days after their last contact.

Your child has <u>not</u> been identified as a close contact and under normal circumstances would not need to make any change to their usual routine, including school attendance. As our caretaking, cleaning and kitchen staff have been affected, however, I have no alternative than to <u>close the school tomorrow</u> to enable me to organise alternative staffing to enable us to open the school safely as soon as possible. It will also enable us to deep clean the school.

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of a new continuous cough and/or a high temperature and/or a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia). If your child, or anyone in your household, develops these symptoms, your whole household must remain at home and not go to work, school or public areas. You should arrange testing for the person who has developed symptoms. When the result is known **please contact school to inform us** and further advice will be available.

How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things we can all do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19:

- wash your hands with soap and water often do this for at least 20 seconds
- use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- wash your hands as soon as you get home
- cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- put used tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards
