Once you have watched the story I would like you to write Tony's diary about the day he had with Grandad. Start your diary with 'Dear Diary, Grandad and I went on the most amazing adventure today'. Describe what he saw and how he felt in the jungle, in the boat, on the aeroplane and in his spaceship. For example 'We travelled through the jungle where there were fierce monkeys popping out from behind tall, slim trees. I was terrified but Grandad was so brave! Next we fell into the river and we got soaked!' I can't wait to read yours!
- Find a simple poem about transport can you learn it off by heart and perform it for your family? I will upload an example to help you (please feel free to use this poem!)
