## **Year 6 SATs - Parent Information**

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you will no doubt be aware, our Year 6 children have their SATs tests coming up in May. We do not want to put the children under any unnecessary pressure and we are very proud of their efforts, especially considering the time missed in school due to the pandemic. All I and the staff at Ellington ask, is for everyone to try their best in everything they do.

I would like to ask for your continued support in the build up to the SATs. **100% Attendance is vital to support progress.** We have four full weeks of teaching after this week before the tests begin and we are covering essential content every single day. We are completing some practice tests in order to help the children be familiar with the test procedure and they are responding positively. I have been working with groups of children, and they have been an absolute pleasure to teach.

During the Easter holidays, we will give the children a homework pack which will support their learning with quick but regular tasks designed to support knowledge retention.

This year the tests start on Monday the 9th May and take place across four days. Please see the timetable below:

Thursday 12th May	Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning 2)	40 minutes
