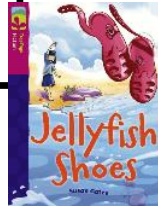


English:

- For your tiles, you could cut up squares from old magazines or coloured paper, or use stickers. You could even paint paper with the colours you want to use and cut up into squares.



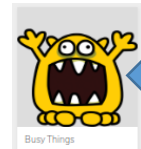
Computing:
