Maths:

- This week we are revising all we have learned this far. Could you make a snowman at home with the correct number of buttons to represent numbers to 5?
- To extend your child you could look at how to make 5 buttons (4 red and 1 blue).



English:

- This week we are looking at the story of One Snowy Night (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=K-8AAisU1w0>).
- Could you think of some words to describe the snowy night? E.g. cold, white, icy. Which sound does your word start with? Can you write the word with a grown up? Which sounds have you used?

Other areas of Learning:

- **Expressive art and design:** Can you make a snowflake from paper? Try cutting lots of different patterns!



- **Communication and language:** Can you discuss the changes that we see in winter? What happens to the trees? To the weather? To our clothes?
- **PSED:** Can you go on a winter walk and spot signs of winter? Help your grown up make a hot chocolate when you get back!
- **Physical development:** Play musical statues with some Christmas songs, make sure to FREEZE when the music stops!
- **Understanding the world:** Have a look at some ice. What does it feel like? What is it made of? What happens to ice over time? Can you make some ice?
