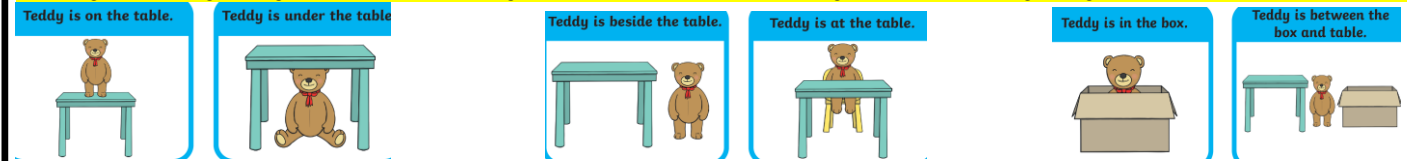

Mathematics:

Our learning objective this week is positional language.

Homework:

-Can you and your grown up work together to describe where your own teddy/ toy is? Here are some examples:



Literacy:

This week in literacy we are continuing to read and learn about the story of The 3 Little Pigs (if you do not have this storybook at home you can find it on google/ youtube).

Homework:

- Can you share your library book with your grown up? (Library books will be changed every Tuesday).
- Can you order and retell parts of The Three Little Pigs story?

Other Areas of Learning:

Expressive Arts and Design:

-Can you make your own house for The Three Little Pigs?



Communication and Language:

- Can you talk about your own house with your grown up? What is it made of? How many rooms does it have? What does it look like?
- Can you retell parts of The Three Little Pigs story by using different voices for the pigs and the wolf?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Talk with your grown up about how the pigs are kind to each other in the story. What things do they do that are kind? How do they help each other?
- Can you play some games (such as board games) with your grown up and focus on sharing/ turn taking?

Physical Development:

-Can you continue to practise your fine motor skills by drawing, colouring, cutting or playing with playdough?

Understanding the World:

- Can you talk with your grown up about the different materials used to make the 3 houses (straw, sticks and bricks)?
- Which material was the strongest? Can you explain to your grown up why/ how you know that?
