Find out about Sea Animals

- Talk to a grown up, look in a book or even look on the Internet, to find out about an animal that lives under the sea.

Look at the Picture

- Choose one of the pictures (found in folder - Looking after our ocean). Talk about what you can see in the picture. Does it look safe? How could we make it look better? What might happen if...?

Ask your child questions to prompt communication and discuss the hazards that you have seen in the pictures.

- Talk to a grown-up about how to stay safe around water

Literacy

Play buried treasure on phonics play -

Look at the rhyming words PowerPoint. Can your child recognise the missing rhyming word? Talk about why they are rhyming words etc.

So far we have practised writing the letters,

m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e l

The next letters we are focusing on are

h and r

You could practise writing these letters in the air with your finger, then practise forming these letters using pens, pencils, paints etc.

The rhymes for these new letters are:

h - down the head, to the hooves and over his back.

r - down his back and curl over his arm.
