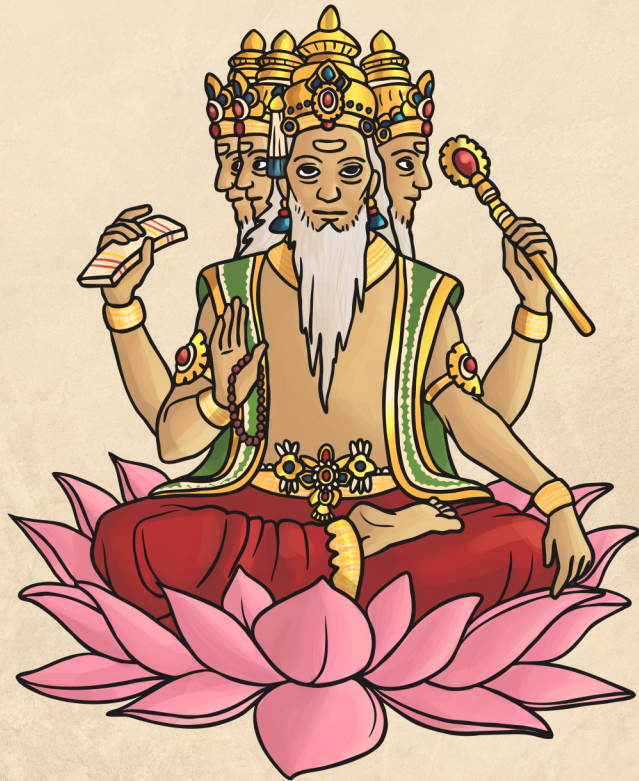


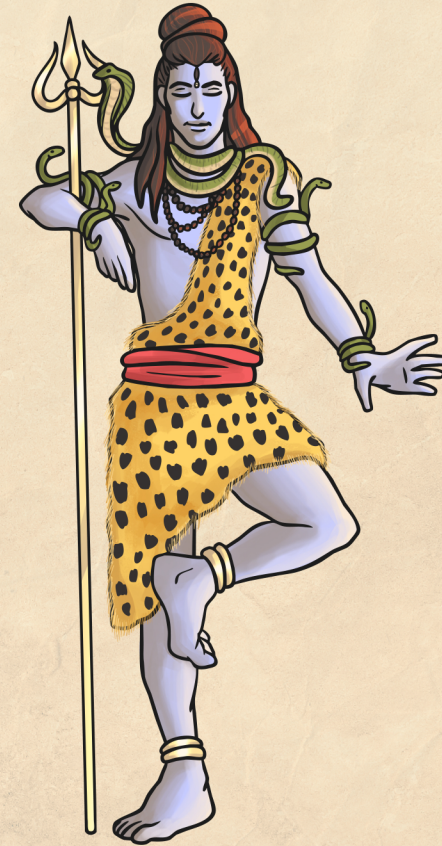
Lord Brahma

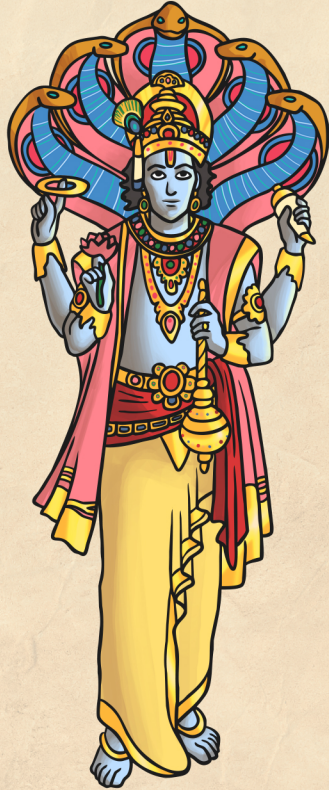
Lord Shiva

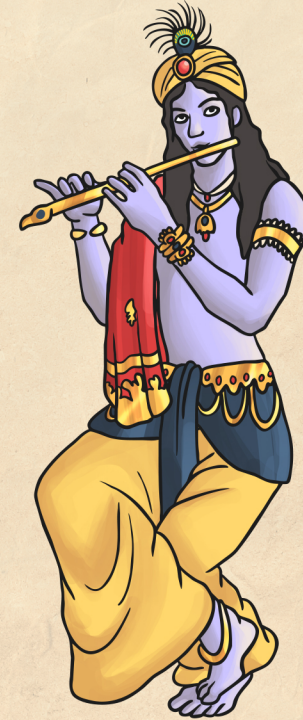
Lord Vishnu

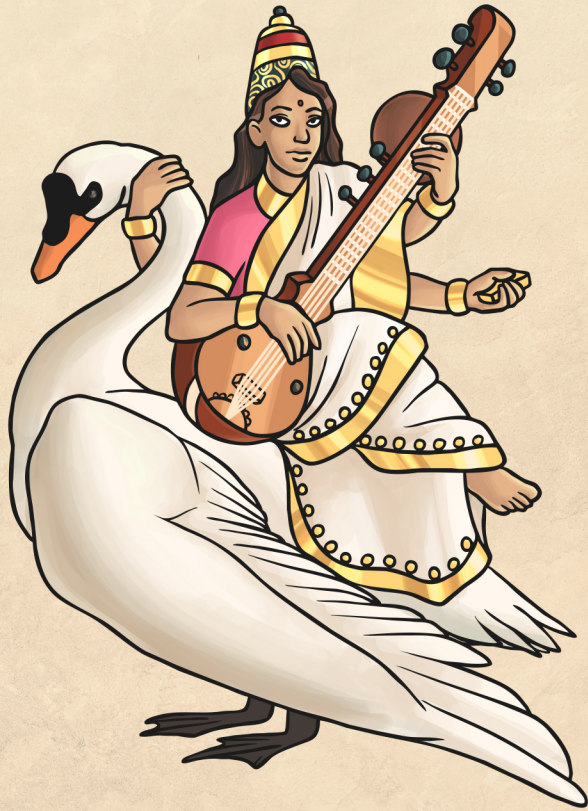
Krishna

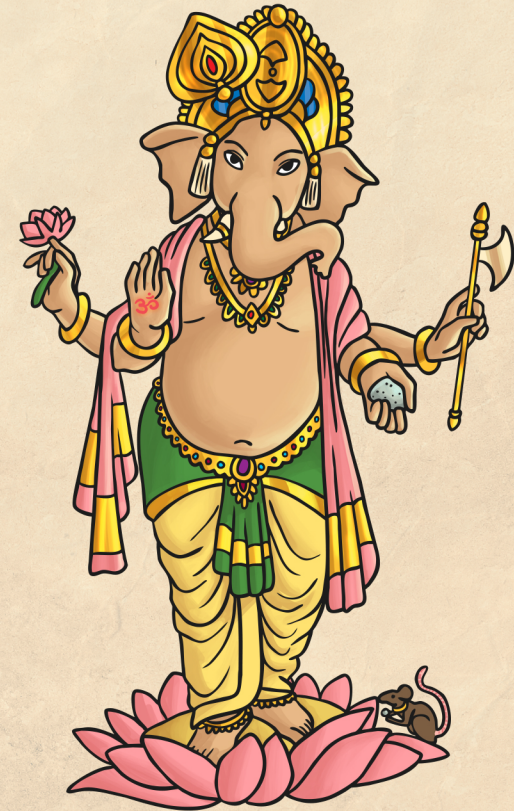
Saraswathi

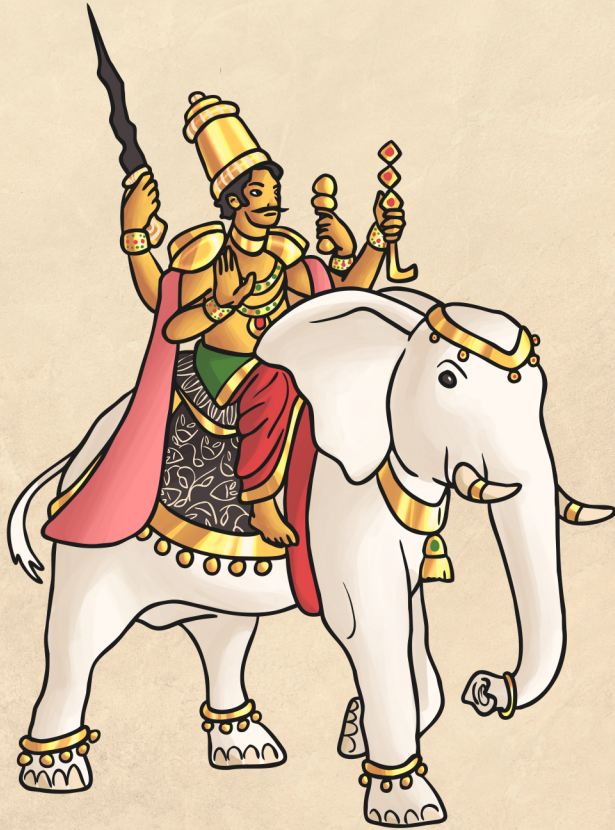
Ganesh

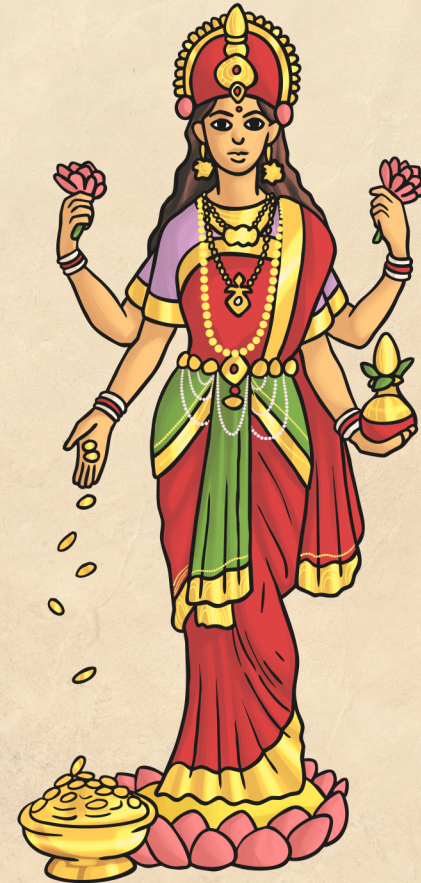
Indra

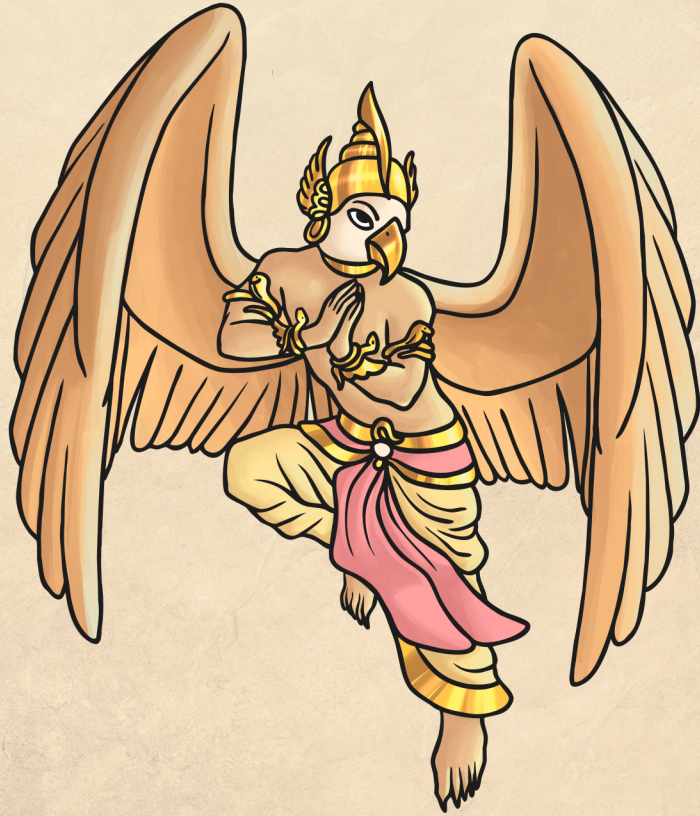
Lakshmi
