<u>Maths:</u>

- This week in maths we will be looking at numbers 4 and 5. Can you count 4 and 5 objects (pasta, socks) from your house? How can you make 4 (2+2)? How can you make 5 (4+1)?
- Can you practise writing numbers 4 and 5?

English:

- This week we are continuing our work on Cinderella.
- Can you choose a character from the story and describe them? Are they evil or kind? Are they poor or rich? Are they old or young? Think about the clothes they wear too (a beautiful blue gown). You could try to write the words using the sounds you know or you could get a grown up to help you.
- Continue to use phonics play to learn a new phase 2 sound. Please revise sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c and k with your child.
- Please continue to share your child's school library book.

Other areas of Learning:

• Expressive art and design: Can you make your own magic wand?



- **Communication and language**: Can you retell the story of Cinderella to your grown up? Can you use actions to help you?
- **PSED**: If you had your very own Fairy Godmother what would you wish for? What would you wear? Where would you live? How would you get there?
- **Physical development**: Can you use pasta and thread/string to make some jewellery for Cinderella to wear to the ball?
- Understanding the world: The story ends with Cinderella and Prince Charming getting married and living happily ever after. Have you ever been to a wedding? What happens? Talk to your grown up and share their experiences.
