

English

During this term, children in our Reading Comprehension will be continuing to work in their fluency, vocabulary and discussion skills and others will continue with their phonics programme.

In English lessons, we will be writing newspaper reports based on the picture book 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey. We will then move onto writing a setting description based on the story 'The Tin Forest' by Helen Ward.

Science

In our Science work we will be looking at Plants and their relationship with light and dark. We will explore what plants need to grow and investigate what happens if they don't get what they need.

Maths

This term we will continue working on our addition and subtraction skills, moving onto adding and subtracting single digit numbers from 3 digit numbers. We will begin to solve more complex division problems and continue to work on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

History

Our next big question in History is 'How did we learn to fly?'. We will look at a range of influential people including the Wright Brothers, Bessie Coleman and Amelia Earhart and their role in the aviation industry. We will also look at the events of the moon landing.

Art & Design

Painting and mixed media: Life in Colour.
Through this topic we will explore mixing colour, creating texture and creating collages.

PSHE

Our next unit in PSHE is 'Safety and the Changing Body'. In this unit we will look at using the internet safely, respecting personal boundaries, road safety and medicine safety.
