



English

During this term, children in our reading comprehension group will continue their work on the Read, Write, INC Comprehension scheme of work to really consolidate our learning from phonics and begin to better understand texts while other children continue to work on strengthening their reading skills during phonics lessons. We will look at two texts in our English lessons including *The Dragon Machine* by Helen Ward and *The Bear and the Piano* by David Litchfield.



Science

In Science we will continue our topic looking at what animals need to survive. We will look at plants and how they grow. We will also begin looking at different lifecycles in our growing up unit.



Maths

This term we will work on consolidating our knowledge of addition and subtraction by introducing column methods. We will continue to work towards our bronze awards by learning our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will also work on fractions, telling the time and shape families.



History

Our big question in History this term is 'What is a Monarch?'. We will explore the life and role of King Charles III and comparing his rule with that of William the Conqueror. We will also look at how the role of the Monarch has changed over time.
