



English

Our reading text will be War Horse by Michael Morpurgo where the children will expand their vocabulary whilst developing their retrieval and inference skills. Our writing stimuli will be a persuasive speech based on 'Little People, Big Dreams—Nelson Mandela', a short film production 'Road's End', and a letter based on our reading text War Horse. We will continue working on our joint handwriting, spelling and Y5 SPaG.



Science

This half term we will be working on the biology element of science where our unit is 'Life Cycles'. Children will explore the various stages of the human life cycle and the gestation periods of mammals. We will also be taking part in a LEAF activity where the children will look at the topic 'Nature is Art'.



French

Clothes: Children will learn the name of common items of clothing, they will also begin to learn how to describe pieces of clothing using adjectives for colours and materials.



Maths

This term we are back revising the four operations before moving back onto fractions. After Fractions, we will be working on amounts, looking at time, measurements and temperature. We will be incorporating plenty of word problems within our maths lesson and the children will be participating in small interventions that will address missing gaps in their fundamental maths skills. Children should continue to use TTRS to work on their timetable knowledge. The children should also continue to practice the four operations 'multiplication, division, addition and subtraction'

E- Safety: Privacy and Security
