



English

Our reading text is *Another Twist in the Tale* by Catherine Bruton. In writing, we will be re-writing fairy tales inspired by the Brothers Grimm and, following this, using our skills for writing to inform to develop a non-chronological report linking to Victorian workhouses. We will also explore poems by Maya Angelou and develop our skills and confidence in performance poetry.



Science

This half term, we are studying living things and their habitats, developing our knowledge of classifications and use of classification keys.



French

We will discuss lessons studied in school, e.g. those we like and dislike.



Maths

We will begin our year with place value before moving onto the formal column methods for the four operations. Using *Winning With Numbers*, we will also be revising any gaps that remain in our knowledge of rapid recall of maths facts as well as practising applying known skills in new contexts.



History

We will be exploring the impact of World War 2 on the people of Britain, including the build-up to the war as well as the Blitz and evacuation.



Art

We will be exploring various types of photography and what makes a good photograph, by editing and evaluating photos.

We will be exploring a unit called *My Healthy Self* and looking at how choices we make now can affect our future selves.
